IU BLOOMINGTON Crime Notice:

December 10th, 2020

In compliance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, a Crime Notice is being issued for a reported burglary.

**REPORTED OFFENSE:** On December 10th, 2020 at 1:00 am, the IUPD received a report of a burglary. IUPD officers were dispatched to 1500 N. Jordan, Zeta Beta Tau, for a motion alarm. When the officers arrived, they discovered the rear courtyard and rear door of the house were unsecured. After a search of the area, officers did not locate any suspects, however, three suspects were observed on CCTV security camera footage stealing items and fleeing the area just prior to IUPD officers arriving.

**TIME AND LOCATION OF OFFENSE:** December 10th, 2020 at 1:00 am at 1500 N. Jordan, Zeta Beta Tau Fraternity.

**SUSPECT:** There are three suspects in the case. The first suspect is described as an Asian male wearing black Adidas shorts with a white stripe, white Asics shoes, and no shirt. The second suspect is described as a white male wearing white shoes, black pants, a gray hoodie, and a ball cap. The third suspect is only described as female.

Racial descriptors alone are not a valid reason to profile or cast suspicion on an individual. In cases of serious crime such as this we may include them only as part of the totality of circumstances, if it may reasonably assist in the identification of the perpetrators.

In an effort to keep yourself and others safe, please consider the following safety tips:

- Always close and lock all doors and windows to your residence, room or office when you leave.
- Always take your keys with you, even if you leave for only a short time.
- Do not lend your keys to anyone you do not know and trust.
- Always hide valuables so they cannot be seen through windows.
- Always report suspicious behavior.
